PROCESSING METHODS

The processing of personal data is done by manual, computerized and telematics tools with logic strictly related to the purposes and for the time strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected. Furthermore, processing is carried out in such a way as to guarantee the security and confidentiality of data in compliance with the Code. Please note that the site uses so-called cookies (see [Information Cookies](#)). Specific security measures are observed to prevent data loss, illicit or incorrect use and unauthorized access. The data may be disclosed to external data processing managers who may be responsible for managing the website (the complete and updated list of those responsible for data processing is available upon request) and single staff members and internal organs competent on the matter.

The processing operations connected to the web services of this site take place at the aforementioned office of the Data Controller and are only handled by personnel expressly authorized by it, or by any third-party suppliers in charge of occasional maintenance operations, appointed as Data Processors pursuant to Article 28 of the RGD.

OPTIONALITY OF DATA SUPPLY

RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED PARTY

The subjects to whom the personal data refer have the right, at any time, to:

- c. obtain data correction and deletion;

- f. oppose the processing at any time and also in the case of treatment for direct marketing purposes;
- g. oppose an automated decision-making process relating to physical persons, including the profiling;
- h. revoke the consent at any time without prejudice to the lawfulness of the treatment based on the consent given prior to the revocation;
- i. propose a complaint to a controlling authority.

NAVIGATION DATA
